If your PCP cannot work you in, you should go to the urgent care center. If you go to the urgent care center, call your PCP for follow-up care. Do not go back to the urgent care center for follow-up care.

\*\*If you go to these urgent care centers at any other time, you will need a referral from your primary care provider (PCP).

\*\*\*Referrals are not required at anytime for members in Foster Care or who have Medicare.
