

Proper COB Procedures for Passport Health Plan and Passport Advantage Members

All PerformRx network pharmacies should follow proper Coordination of Benefit (COB) procedures when billing Part B medications for members with dual-coverage between Medicare and Medicaid.

For Passport Advantage members, please submit Part B prescription claims to Passport Health Plan as an online COB medication claim through Argus. Some examples include:

- Nebulizer inhalation solutions
- Glucose monitors
- Test strips (for glucose monitors)
- Lancets
- Immunosuppressant drugs (for a Medicare-covered organ transplant)
- Certain agents to control nausea (if used within 48 hours of chemotherapy)

For Passport Health Plan members with a primary Medicare insurance plan other than Passport Advantage, please submit Part B prescription claims to the primary Medicare insurance plan (typically 80%). Then submit the remainder (typically 20%) to Passport Health Plan. The member's copayment is then determined by the amount leftover after both insurance plans have adjudicated the claim.

For Passport Health Plan members without Medicare coverage, please ensure there is not another primary payer. As a Medicaid insurance plan, Passport Health Plan will always be the payer of last resort.
