New Benefit:

Effective January 1, 2008, Passport Health Plan will reimburse practitioners to administer topical fluoride varnish to children ages four and under. Eligible members may receive fluoride varnish up to a maximum of two times every 12 months.

The Plan will reimburse practitioners \$15.00 for the administration of topical fluoride varnish.

Provider Action Needed:

Topical fluoride applications are one of the most effective ways to prevent, slow down, and even reverse early cavities in children. We encourage practitioners to administer topical fluoride as needed.

Reimbursement for the administration of topical fluoride varnish will be generated based on the HCPCS code D1206. Please share this important information with the appropriate staff in your organization.
