All Passport Health Plan (PHP) providers

Background:

Effective January 1, 2008, PHP will reimburse practitioners for administration of the human papillomavirus (HPV) vaccine Gardasil® (code 90649) for PHP members ages 19-26.

Local health departments may administer the vaccine for PHP members ages 19-26.

Members will be receiving communications regarding this benefit.

PHP members ages 9-18 will continue coverage through the Vaccines for Children (VFC) program.

Provider Action Needed:

All PHP practitioners may administer the HPV vaccine effective January 1, 2008.

Please direct all KyHealth Choices Medicaid members (who are not enrolled in Passport Health Plan) to their local health departments for the HPV vaccine.
