Dear Passport Health Plan Practitioner,

As you may know, the Kentucky Department for Medicaid Services (DMS) recently announced reimbursement increases for practitioners. This announcement follows University Health Care, Inc.'s (UHC) communication of reimbursement increases to our provider partners. These increases were implemented on April 1 and May 1, 2007, with additional increases planned for July 1, 2007. The UHC-sponsored increases are in recognition of your hard work on behalf of our members and reflect the Plan's commitment to our collaborative and long-term success.

Our commitment to our provider partners is further demonstrated by our concerted efforts to ensure that Passport Health Plan (PHP) practitioners were effectively represented in recent statewide decisions regarding increases for practitioners outside the PHP region. As a result, there are additional DMS-funded monies available to PHP. We are pleased to announce the Plan will distribute these monies as an additional increase to our PHP practitioners. A communication outlining the details of the increase, including the distribution methodology and effective date, will be sent to you in the very near future.
