Re: Provider Recognition Program 2007 Reconsideration Process, Phase I: Breast Cancer Screenings Due May 16, 2008

Dear Primary Care Provider (PCP):

The Provider Recognition Program payments to be awarded beginning September 2008 will be based on healthcare services provided to members assigned to your PCP group during 2007. As part of the initial reconsideration process, we have enclosed a list of members who should have received breast cancer screenings during 2006 or 2007 and who were assigned to your practice for at least seven (7) months during 2007.

You have an opportunity to improve your scores for the breast cancer screening measure by providing medical record documentation of **services occurring or services not required** per PHP's Clinical Practice Guidelines* or its sources. **The Plan must receive all requests for reconsideration no later than May 16, 2008.** Please send all requests for reconsideration to the attention of:
